



HANOI – SAPA – HANOI

Duration: 3 days 2 nights

Sapa is a small and old town on top of mountain region of Vietnam, there are many places to explore, many attractive things to see, many different people in from nay ethnic groups to get their local culture you will not see in any other places.

Fansipan is the highest mountain peak of Vietnam at 3,143 m. Hundred years ago in French colonel, surveyors and cartographers have already been there to set up survey mark. Nowadays with cable car from Sapa, you will take the trip flying over the deep jungle to Fansipan peak, the way to the peak seem to go to heaven.

Day 1	Hanoi – Sapa – Ham Rong Moutain (L, D)
<p><u><i>Include:</i></u> Private transportation Hotel: Amazing, Chau Long or similar (4 star) English speaking tour guide Entrance fees Meals: lunch, dinner</p>	<p>06.30 – 07:00: Pick up at your hotel in Hanoi. Start departure to Sapa. The tour guide will explain to you about the trip and Sapa. Along the way, you will have chance to contemplate the beauty of northwest mountains that terraced fields are sparkling in sunlight or dim in thick fog. Have a short break for 30 minutes then continue the trip to Sapa. 12.30pm: Arrive in Sapa, check in hotel and have lunch. Afternoon: Ham Rong Botanical Garden: don't miss the lovely botanical gardens above the main square in town with their spectacular viewpoint from the top. There are fabulous views of the town and the wider landscape as well as tended gardens to visit. This park is essentially a long cobblestone walkway to the top of Ham Rong Mountain. It's a strenuous climb, but the panoramic view at the top is well worth tackling all those stairs. Along the way, there are countless potted orchids, beautiful landscaped gardens and a few really tacky statues of cartoon characters like Scooby Doo and Mickey Mouse. One word of caution, the stone stairs could be treacherous on a rainy or misty day. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Sapa.</p>
To Day 2	Sapa – Fansipan Summit (B, L, D)
<p><u><i>Include:</i></u> Private transportation Hotel: Amazing, Chau Long or similar (4 star) English speaking tour guide</p>	<p>06.30 – 07:00 am: Breakfast at hotel. Transfer to Fansipan Cable Station for an amazing trip to reach the Indochina Roof, 3143m above the sea level: Starting by cable car and step up to the Peak, enjoy the fresh air and the beautiful landscapes from the high.</p>



<p>Entrance fees Cable cars Meals: Breakfast, lunch, dinner</p>	<p>Back to hotel. Have lunch at the restaurant. Afternoon: Free time for visiting Sapa Church, relax, taking photos or you can rent a motorbike at your charge, with or without driver to visit Lao Chai – Ta Van Village. After dinner, you are free to explore the charm of Sapa by night, enjoy roasted corn, baked eggs beside charcoal fire or go shopping. Especially on Saturday night, we highly recommend a stop at the Love Market – one of the unique cultures of ethnic minorities in northwest of Vietnam. Overnight stay at hotel in Sapa.</p>
<p>Day 3 <u>Include:</u> Private transportation English speaking tour guide Entrance fees Meals: Breakfast, lunch</p>	<p>Sapa – Cat Cat Village – Hanoi (B, L) AM: After breakfast, you will start trekking to Cat Cat Village which is occupied by the Black H’mong tribe. Here, you can see the hydroelectric power station which was built by the French in twentieth century. You will experience the tribal way of life of ethnic minorities while enjoying wonderful views of the terraced rice paddy fields and the waterfall in Cat Cat village. Visitors will also experience culture, unique customs, traditional crafts such as weaving, touching carved silver, forged agricultural tools. Come back the hotel. Back to Sapa for lunch PM: Drive back to Hanoi. Arrival in Hanoi in the early evening</p>
