



### Monument of the European Geodesy

#### MONUMENT OF THE EUROPEAN GEODESY

The marble column, enclosed by a stylised iron balustrade, marks a geodetic and magnetic measurements point, established in 1872. The geodetic arc of the 52nd parallel north passes here, running across whole Europe for about 6,000 km – from the Irish island of Valentia to the city of Orsk in Russia's Ural Mountains. For many years, the point used to be mistakenly called the 'Warsaw Meridian'. The survey station was designated in the course of measurements of the geodetic shape and size of the Earth, carried out on the European continent between 1861 and 1890. Both in Warsaw and along the majority of the geodesic arc's eastern section, the measurements were carried out by a Polish land surveyor, engineer and traveller, general Józef Żyliński.

The column survived the World War II and remains an original, intact element of the historical Theater Square. In 2022, during the Congress of the International Federation of Surveyors (FIG) in Warsaw, the column has been declared a European Geodesy Monument, a unique relic of the 19th century science and technology.
