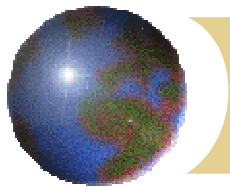
- Eilat, Israel, 3-8 May 2009 - Surveyors' Key Role in Accelerated Development: New Horizons across the Red Sea

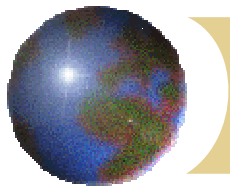
# *7<sup>th</sup> FIG Regional Conference, 2009*

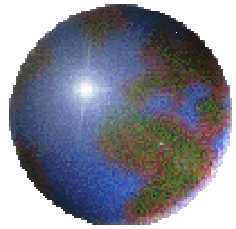
# *FIG Congress 2010*

- ❖ **Sydney, Australia, 11-16 April 2010**
