Digital maps can then link any information to where it is relevant.

## **‘Unlocking the Wealth of Information’**

**Cadastral Maps are the key to Land Governance:**

- Digitising provides a cost effective digital solution
- Aerial imagery can assist in orientation and improving the spatial quality

Older aerial photography and maps can be oriented to the database and terrestrial photography can also be linked to a location.

## **‘Unlocking the Wealth of Information’**

**Where Survey Records are The Authoritative Spatial Document**

- Usually mapping representations are available to digitise to create a Fit for Purpose database
- To validate any boundary on the ground requires a survey
