The Peutinger Map

The map is named for Konrad Peutinger into whose possession it came in the early Renaissance. It is thought to be a Medieval copy of a map made for Marcus Agrippa, who was Augustus's military chief and, later, the "general contractor" of Augustus's renovation of Rome. The image above is a small segment of a modern copy of the Medieval copy. The image shows the area around the bay of Naples which was in the "red zone" of the 79 AD eruption of Vesuvius.

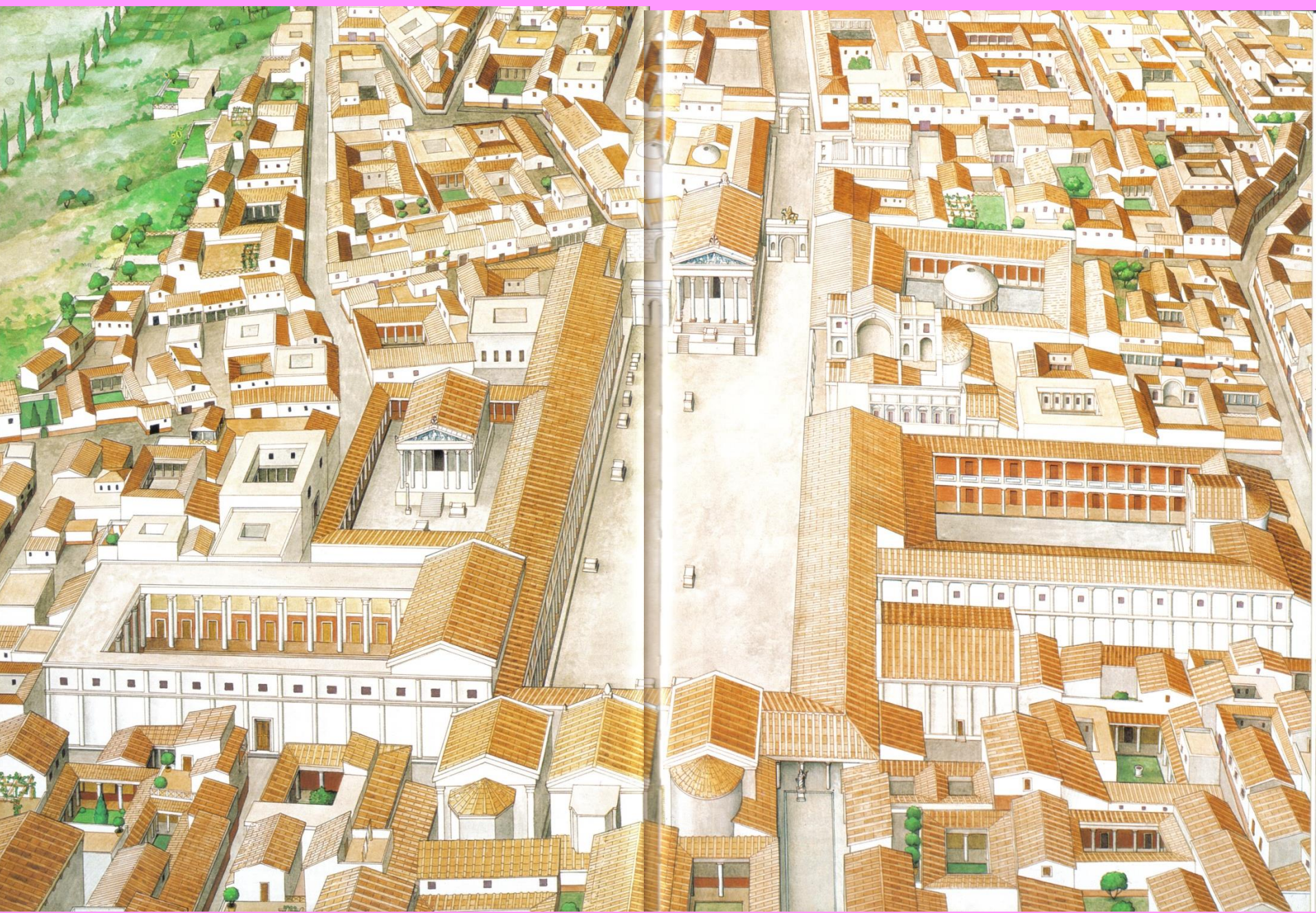

SHOWING REGIOS I TO IX**



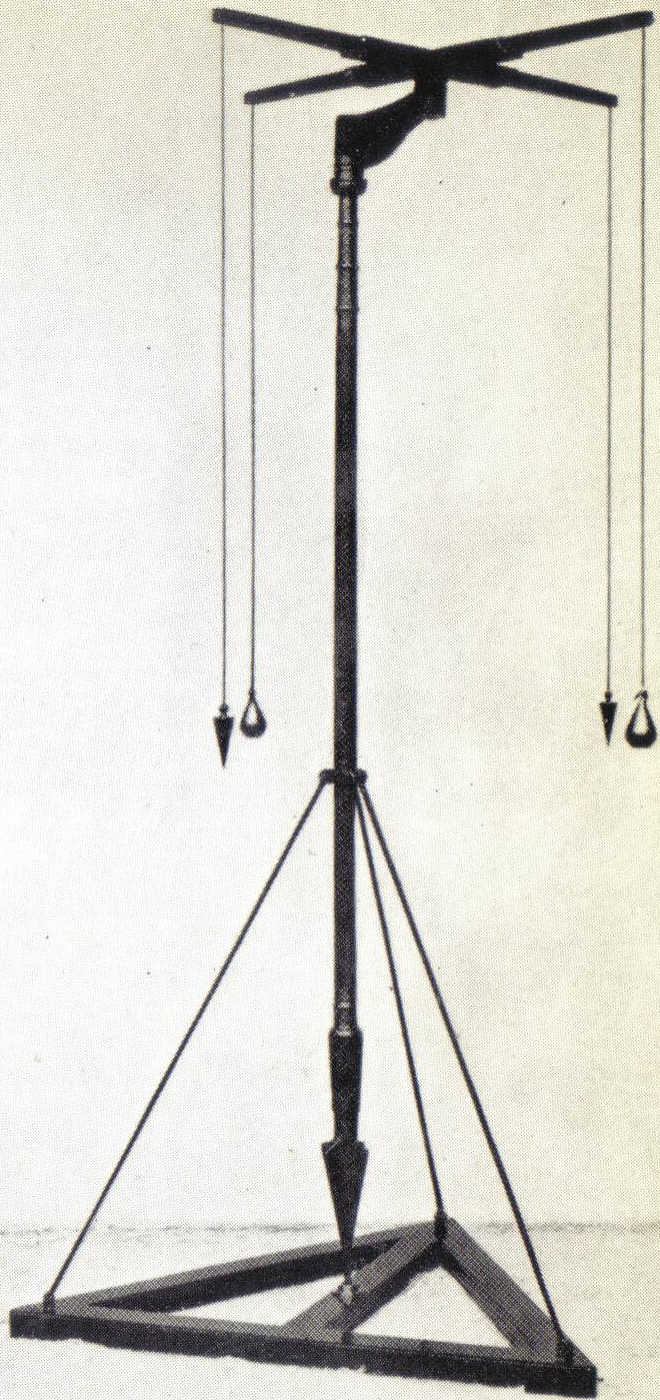

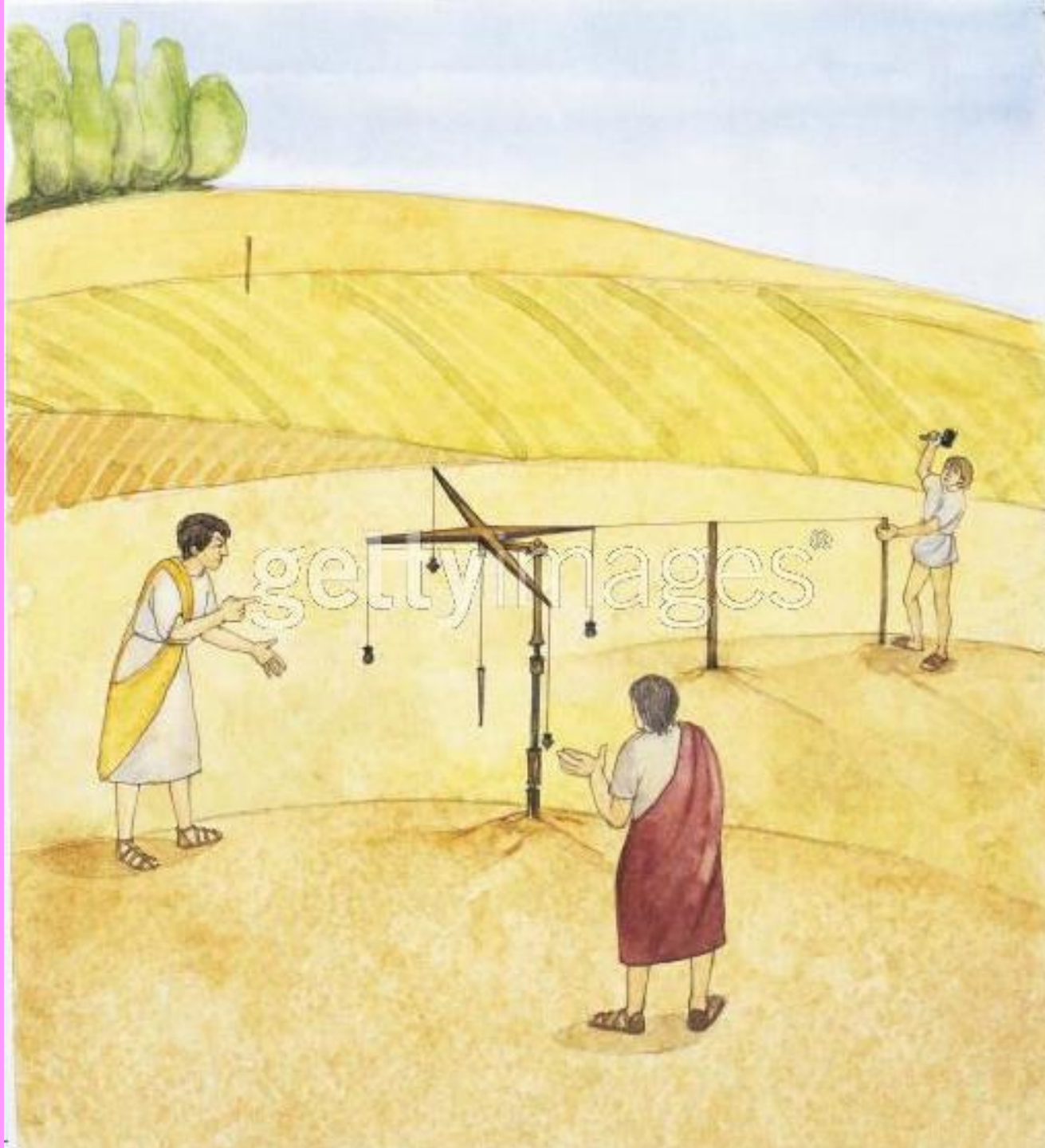
A CENTURATION STONE SHOWING THE MARKINGS ON ITS TOP



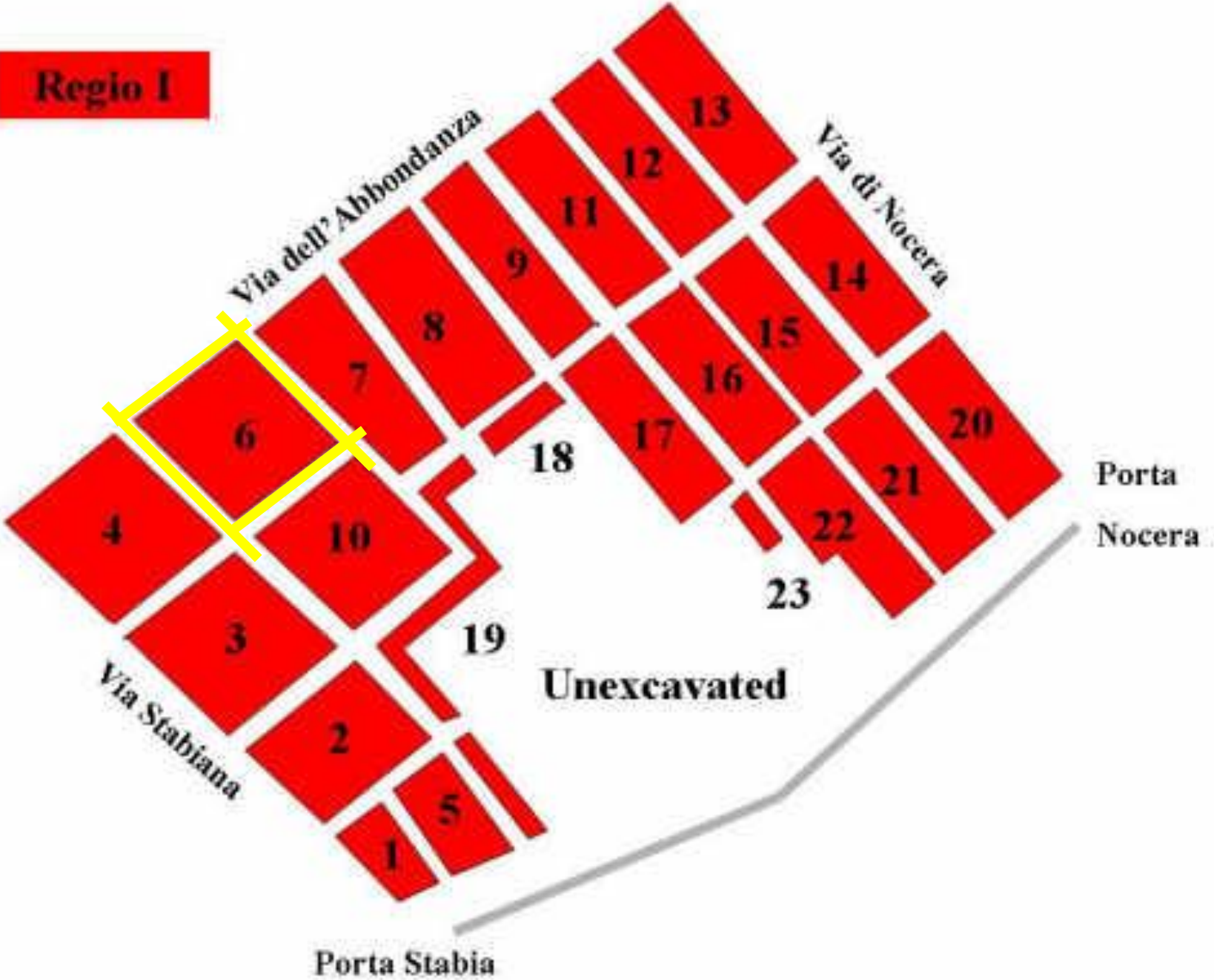

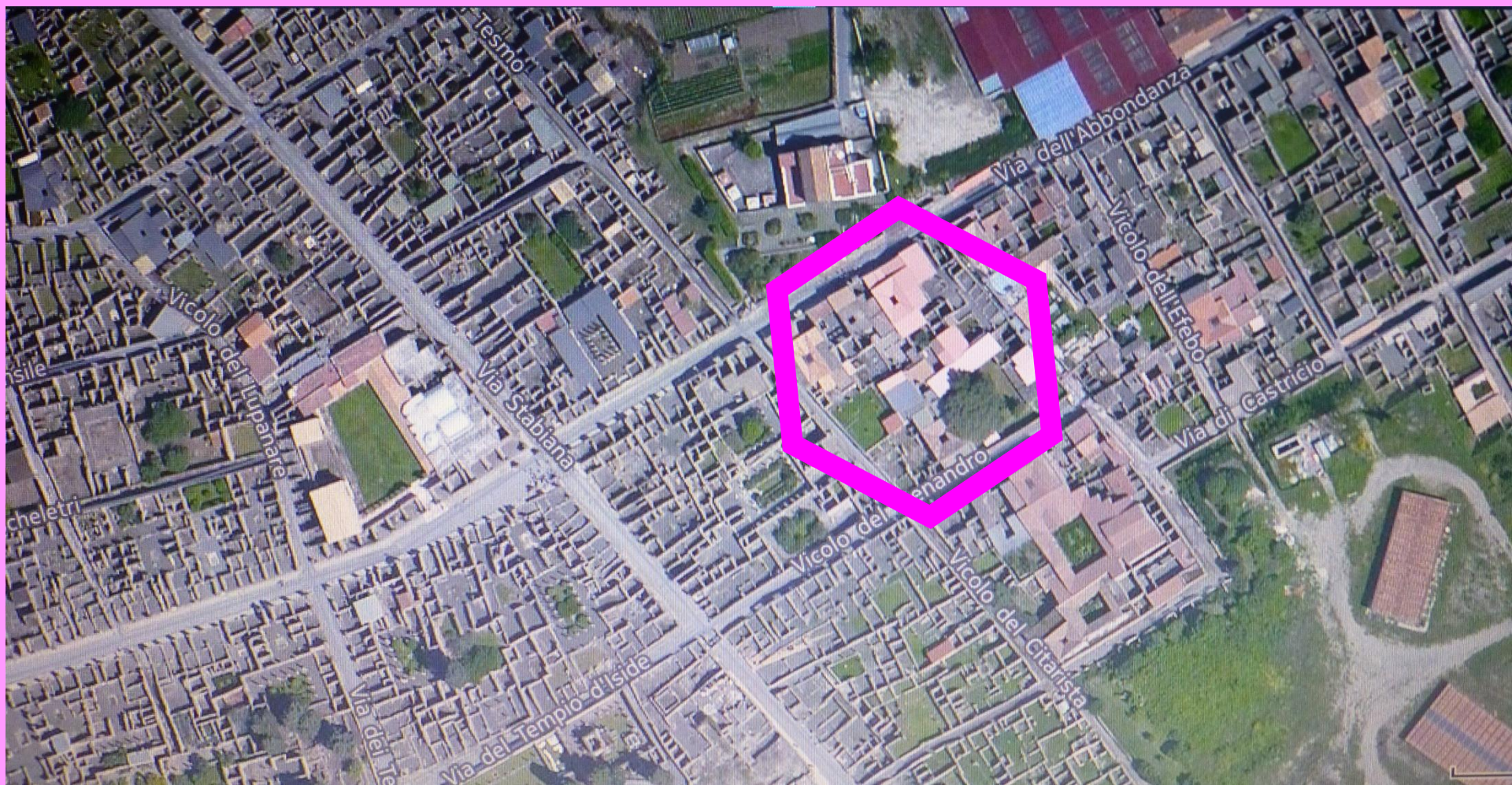

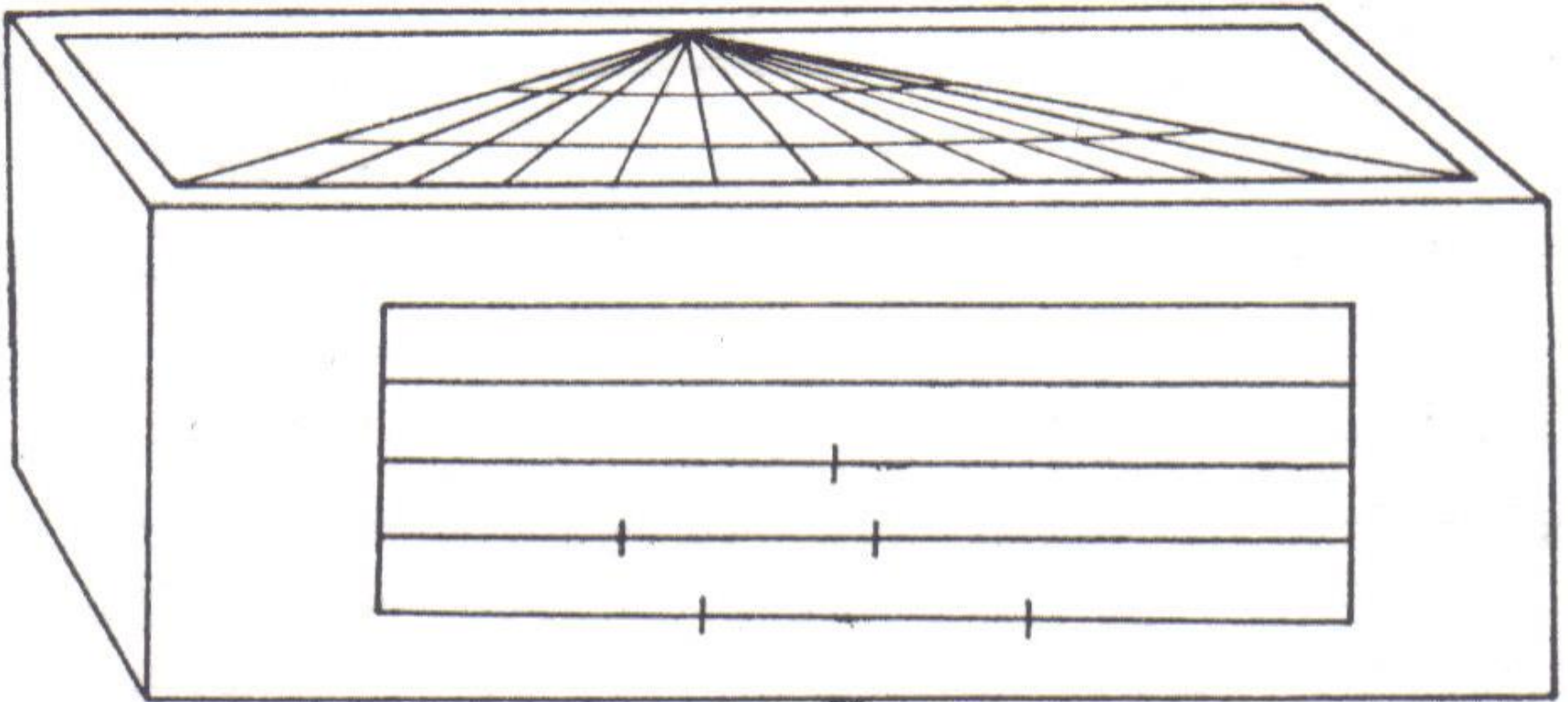

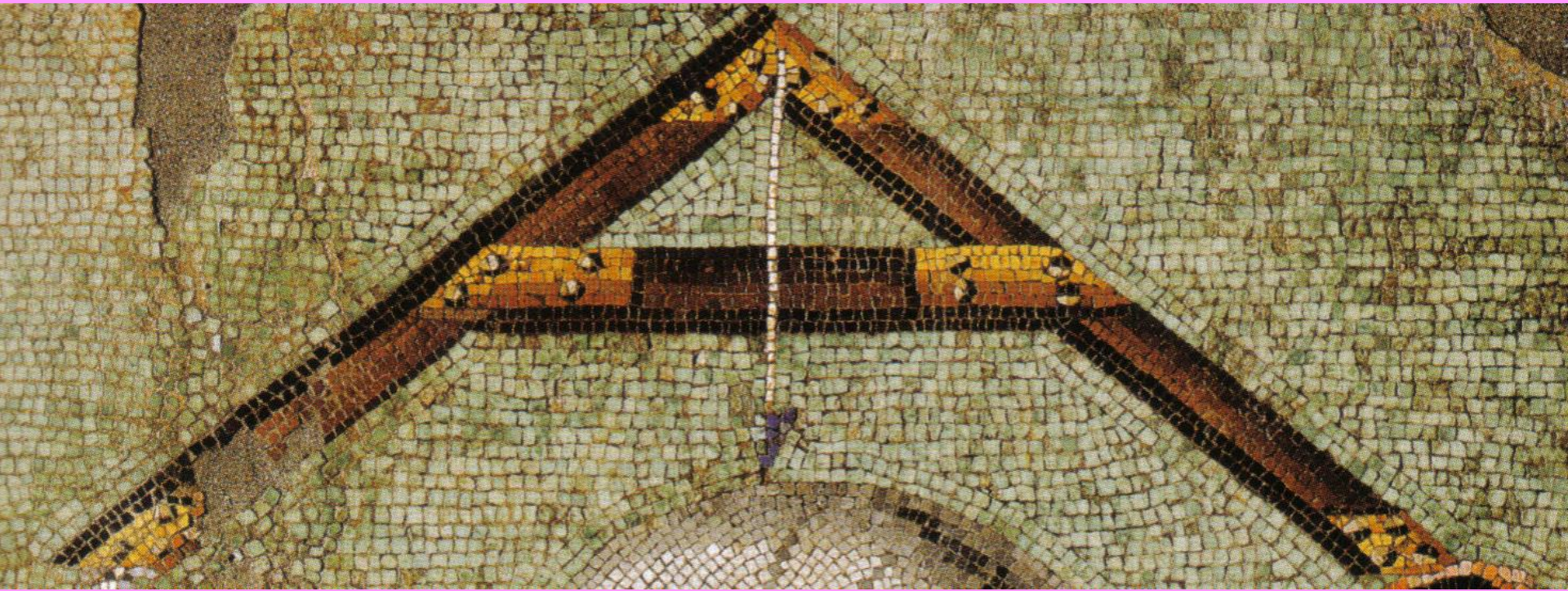

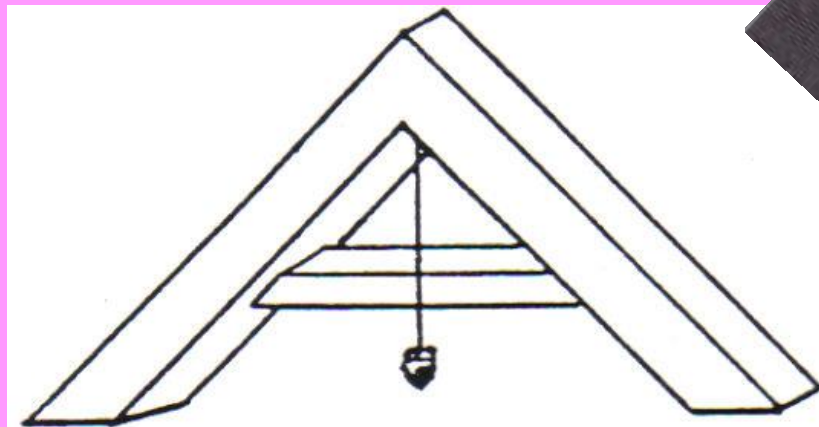
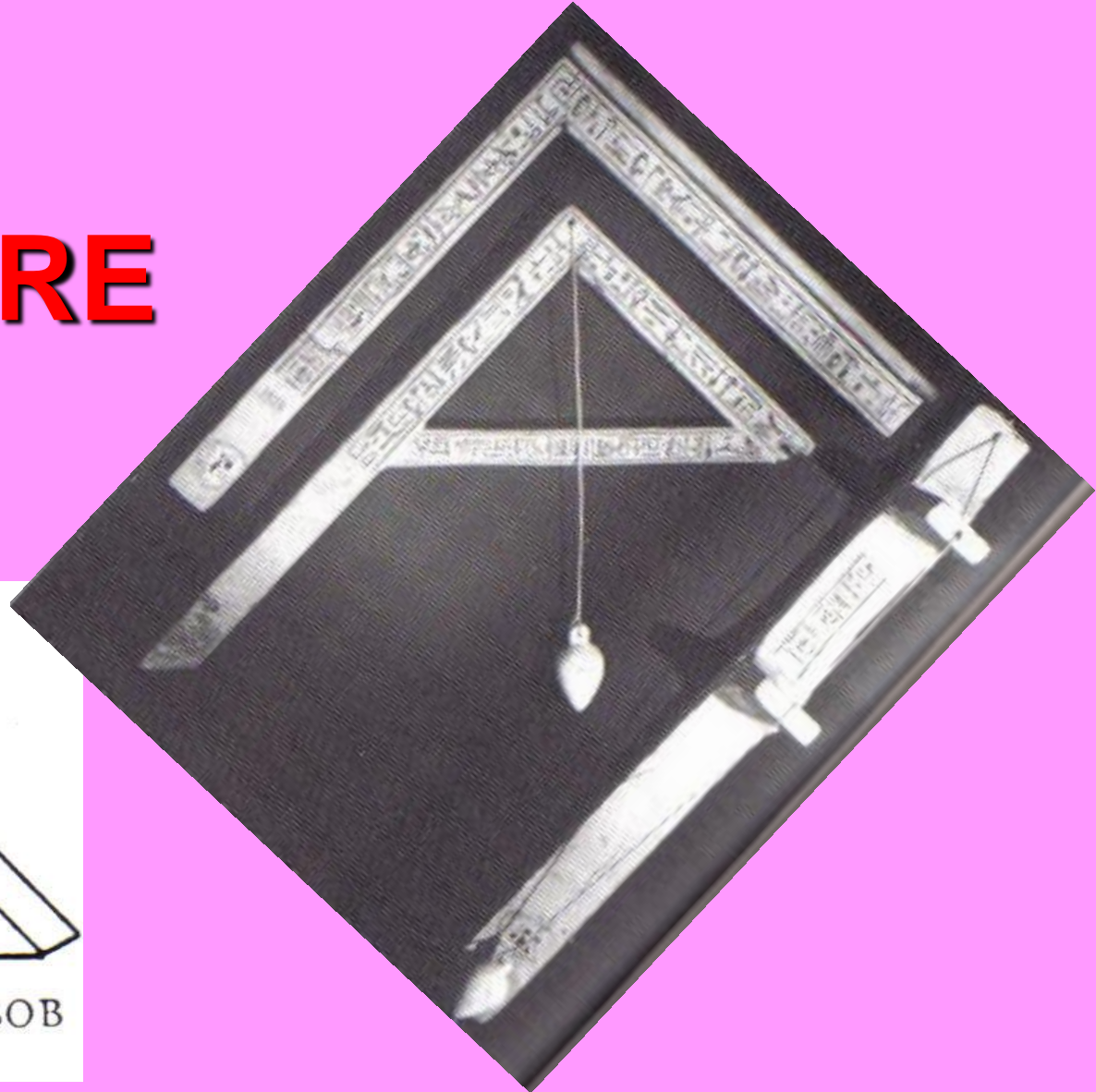
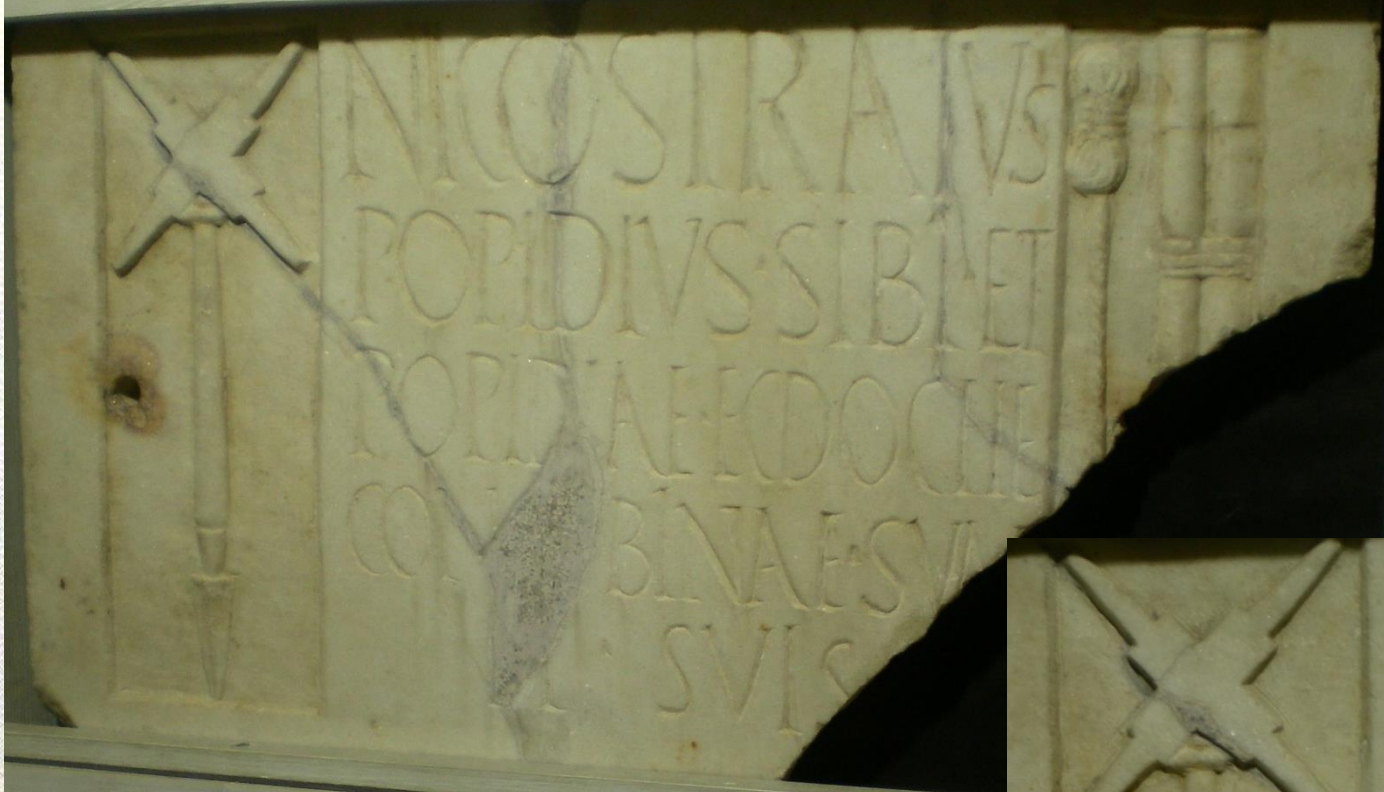


Figure 2. EGYPTIAN PLUMB-BOB
