	A profession exercised on the basis of appropriate professional qualifications, individually, under one 's own responsibility and in a professionally independent way, offering intellectual and conceptual services in the interests of the client and the public ».	
Ex	ercising a liberal profession.	
	means having to provide services that are characterised by their high level of technical skill and their high quality.	
	means following a set of fundamental values such as independence, probity and compliance with professional secrecy.	
	means guaranteeing these fundamental values by carrying out ongoing training and accepting that one may be punished by one 's peers if one infringes the code of ethics or fails to go by the book.
