

## New Initiatives (2015-2017)

- 2016 Established FIG Commission Publication Author Support Grant: author support grants of up to 28,000 euros spread over a maximum of four years. The grants are aimed at (1) increasing FIG publications by authors who reside in low-income, lower-middle or upper-middle income economy countries, and (2) contributing to the implementation of part of a Commission's Working Plan.
- 2016 Presented first PhD Scholarship award of 7,000 euros to Wallace Mukupa (Zambia).
- 2017 Approved grant funding in support of FIG Young Surveyors Network Volunteer Community Surveyor Program, a joint competence based volunteer program initiated by Global Land Tool Network (facilitated by UN-Habitat)(GLTN) and the International Federation of Surveyors Young Surveyors Network (FIG-YSN).
- 2017 Authorized production of informational videos on how to apply for FIG Foundation grants.




