- support from Norway since 2006




















2011 – lidar scanning and DTM for flood-affected areas

2012 – standards and pilot production of digital base map

2013 – system architecture for new registration system

2014 - ongoing: MoldLIS development

2015 - new generation of nationwide orthophoto 20 cm and DTM

2016 - pilot project on use of drones to facilitate mass property registration

2017 - ongoing: New nationwide digital base map for NSDI












